Know all men by these presents that I Elizabeth Wille of Southampton County England for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear to my son Horace Wille of the County and State of Virginia mentioned as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said Horace Wille at or before the executing and delivery of these presents have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Horace Wille his heirs and assigns forever all and singular parts and parcels of said Elizabeth Wille maiden land lying on the west side of the river of James in that part of said tract that is not otherwise disposed of To have and to hold the said land unto the said Horace Wille his Executors administrators and assigns forever And the said Elizabeth Wille for herself her Executors and administrators the said land unto the said Horace Wille his Executors administrators against the claim or claims of him the said Elizabeth Wille her Executors and administrators and against the claim or claims of all and every persons or persons whatsoever shall and lawfully claimant and forever defend them by these presents. This Indenture made the 15th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty between Matthew Forler and Jacey his wife of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the one part and John E. Croft of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Matthew Forler and Jacey his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said John E. Croft at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Matthew Forler and Jacey his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John E. Croft his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton lying on the West side of Black Water River the land of Matthew Forler Rhoda McClemy and others marked and bounded as follows Beginning at a person in the line of Morris Branch a corner in the line of William Forler thence up a road branch 19 1/2 poles to a small dogwood a corner of said Croft in said Forler's line thence 78 94 poles to Black Water River then up said River the several courses thereof and bounded thence 110 1/2 poles to the mouth of Morris Branch thence up said Branch the several courses thereof and bounded thence 157 poles to the beginning Containing sixty three and a half acres more or less the reverse and reversions Remainder and remainder of a party and other parts of the profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John E. Croft his heirs and assigns forever And the said Matthew Forler and Jacey his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John E. Croft his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Matthew Forler and Jacey his wife or either of them their heirs or either of them and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and lawfully claimant and forever defend them by these presents.
