This Indenture made this 18th day of February in the Year of our Lord 1830 between Jesse West and Leona West his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Lewis Horrell of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Jesse West and Leona his wife for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and seven dollars and no more of the Common Law of the said State of Virginia paid by the said Lewis Horrell at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents entailed and each of them do the hereby grant bargain and sell alien and sell convey and confirm unto the said Lewis Horrell his heirs and assigns forever all their right title interest claim or demands of in and to a certain main tract or parcel of land of which Truacy Bryan's father of said Leona are seized and possessed known by the name of the School's plantation situate lying and being within the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Peter's containing by estimation or appraised acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of said Lewis Horrell William Bryan and others together with all right title interest claim and demand of in and to their proportionable part of the aforesaid tract or parcel of said land To have and to hold the aforesaid right title interest claim or demand of them the said Jesse West and Leona his wife of in and to the aforesaid and in said tract or parcel of Land and premises unto the said Lewis Horrell his heirs and assigns forever To and for the only proper use and behoof of the said Lewis Horrell his heirs and assigns forever and the said Jesse West and Leona his wife for themselves their heirs Executors adm^{rs} &c and each of them doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Lewis Horrell his heirs adm^{rs} &c signify that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title to the land hereby conveyed against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof the said Jesse West and Leona his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and date first within written
