between James Edward of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Gray Edward of
the County aforesaid of the other part. WITNESSETH that the said James Edward for &
in consideration of the sum and full sum of One hundred dollars current money of the United States of
America in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and the said James Edward
hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto
the said Gray Edward and to his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land in Southampton
County aforesaid which James Edward Jr. and Martha his wife convey and confirmed to the
aforesaid James Edward by him deed bearing date the 15th day of October 1825 and is recorded in
the Clerks office for the County Court of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation one
hundred and eighty four acres and one half acre. to the same more or less with the revision and
reversions remaining and remaining rents issues and profits therefrom by the known
representatives thereof. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all and every the
appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Gray Edward his heirs and assigns forever. And the
said James Edward his heirs Executors and administrators tract or parcel of land with all and every
