 ton County aforesaid which James Edward Jr. and Martha his wife conveyed and confirmed to the
 aforesaid James Edward by their deed bearing date the 15 day of October 1825 and is of record in
 the Clerk's office for the County Court of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation one
 hundred and eighty four acres and one half acre be the same more or less with the reversions and
