This Indenture made this 20th day of February one thousand eight hundred and thirty between Maria Crompler of the County of Southampton of the one part and Thomas Blowing of the said County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Maria Crompler for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen dollars to her in hand paid paid by the said Thomas Blowing before the making and delivery hereof the receipt whereof the said Maria Crompler doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Blowing his heirs and assigns forever her undivided part of a tract of land containing fifty two acres be the same more or less which tract of land was her mother's property of her father West Tynes Land bounded as follows beginning at the fork of the dam Branch at Arrington Bridge then along a line of marked trees to a white oak a corner to Solomon Crompler's then Spivey's line thence to a sassafras a corner tree to West Tynes and Solomon Crompler then along a line of marked trees to the said West Tynes to a sassafras a corner tree to Arrington Bridge then along a line of marked trees to the head of the said dam And the reversion And reversions Remainder And remainder thereof and profits thereof and also all the Estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever her the said Maria Crompler and her heirs forever or in and to the same or any part thereof To have and to hold the said land and premises with appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Thomas Blowing to his heirs and assigns to the only purposes and behoof of him the said Thomas Blowing his heirs and assigns forever And the said Maria Crompler for her part her heirs &c doth covenant promise and agree with the said Thomas Blowing his heirs &c by these presents that the said Maria Crompler the said land and premises every part and parcel thereof unto the said Thomas Blowing his heirs &c against the lawful claim title and demand of her the said Maria Crompler her heirs &c and all and every other person or persons claiming shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend by these Witnesses whereof I the said Maria Crompler hath subscribed set my hand and affixed my seal this day and year first above written
