This Indenture made and entered into this 23rd day of January in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and thirty between Mrs A Brown & Susan S his wife of the County of Southampton of the first part and John Shepherd of the same County of the second part Witnesseth the said Brown and wife for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand and three hundred dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them secured to be paid by the said John Shepherd before the making and delivery of these presents which is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold granted and conveyed and by these presents do bargain and sell grant and convey unto the said John Shepherd a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County aforesaid bounded by the main public road leading from Millfield to Junction on the south on the East and North by the lands of Benjamin Williams on and on the West by the lands of Lewis H Cloud containing one hundred acres be the same more or less together with the houses fixtures and other appurtenances To have and to hold the said bargain premises and appurtenances to him the said John Shepherd and his heirs assigns to his and thurs only proper use and behoof forever And the said Brown and wife for themselves and thurs heirs covenant to and with the said John Shepherd and his heirs that he shall have a good and perfect title to the said bargain premises and enjoy quiet possession of the same In Testimony whereof they these herewith set their hands and seals this day and year last above written

This Indenture made and entered into this 15th day of March 1830 between George Gray and John S Mason of the County of Southampton of the first part and Benjamin Burs of the same County of the second part Witnesseth the said Gray and Mason for and in consideration of the sum of money due to the said Gray and Mason specified bearing date on the 23rd day of March 1829 and of record in the County aforesaid in the name of the said Benjamin Burs convey or a certain parcel of land situate in the said County and fully described in the said deed of Trust and whereas the said Benjamin Burs died on the 15th day of March last fully paid and satisfied to the said Gray the debt and interest due on the said Bond which is hereby acknowledged Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of the above named George S Gray and John S Mason have released and claimed and confirmed and by these presents do release quit claim & confirm unto the said Mrs Burs and to her heirs and assigns all the right title and interest to them conveyed by the said deed of Trust and no other Given under our Hand and Seal this day and year above written
