This Indenture made this 1st day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between Henry Brown of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and State of Maryland and March 18th 1830 and seventy two Cts with interest thereon besides other debts in law executed to the said Henry Brown by Martha Bradshaw which said seven Cts are returned to Martha Bradshaw and all
 related to the said factory of black parties and the said Henry Brown has related to the said Martha
 Bradshaw a negro man Tom belonging to her during her natural life the said Tom was made over
 to the said Henry Brown for the above named sum which is on record reference may be had in the
 Office of this County will more fully appear. and it is so that the said Henry Brown who has had
 a bill of sale in the said Tom and said sum himself entitled to the said negro man Tom after the decease
 of the said Martha Bradshaw. To whom the said Bill of sale is also on record. Hence to Brown to Brown
 to that end. I Henry Brown do hereby release the said negro man Tom from that circumstance
 and confirm him altogether to the use of Martha Bradshaw during her ^{natural} life that is to say that the
 said negro man Tom must not be conveyed or heriot of this County except by giving bond and
 approved security to be forth coming at or before the decease of Martha Bradshaw. With the

This Indenture made this 24th day of December one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine
 between Henry Moore of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of one part and Sepe S. West of the
 said County and State of the other part. With the said Henry Moore Executor to the last
 will and Testament of Edmund Drury dec^d. both agreeable to said Will make sale of the tract of land
 whereon Edmund Drury died seized and possessed of unto Sepe S. West for the sum of Four hundred and
 twenty three dollars thirty five and half Cts to come in hand paid or secured to be paid by Sepe S. West
 the receipt whereof the said Henry Moore hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents
 doth grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said Sepe S. West his heirs and assigns forever
 all that tract of land belonging to the said Edmund Drury dec^d lying on West side of Flat Swamp
 between in said County and containing by old survey two hundred and six acres be the same more
 or less and bounded as follows. Beginning at a willow oak near Flat Swamp thence along
 Turners line to a black Jack in Charles Sudken's line thence along Charles Sudken's line to
 Rebecca Turners line from thence to Aaron Welfle's line thence to William H. Bess line thence
 to a red oak thence to a post oak at the corner of Mr West's line thence to a spring brook
 in John Wmacks line thence down the branch to Flat Swamp thence up the swamp to the
 beginning to have and to hold the said tract of land with all and singlars appurtenances
 therunto belonging unto the said Sepe S. West his heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry
 Moore doth for himself his heirs Executors and assigns forever defend the right and title
 of the said tract of land unto the said Sepe S. West his heirs and assigns forever. With the
