This Indenture made this 12th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and thirty between John Shirred and his wife Sally E. of the one part and George Littlebury
 and late of North Carolina and Littlebury Mason of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia
 of the other part Witnesses that said John Shirred and Sally E. for and in consideration
 of the sum of Nine hundred and twenty five dollars to them in kind paid by the said Littlebury Mason
 at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Shirred
 wife doth hereby acknowledge and forever acquit and discharge the said Littlebury Mason of
 the same hath granted bargain sold and aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents
 doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Littlebury Mason his heirs
 and assigns one tract or parcel of land containing by estimation two thousand and thirty three
 or thereabouts more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and state of Virginia
 lying on the three adjoining the lands of Sipe Holt and John and Samuel Drury. To have and
 to hold the aforesaid land with all the profits commodities and issues and all and singular the
 appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to him the said Littlebury Mason
 his heirs and assigns forever To have and to hold free from all hindrances and incumbrances
 and the said John Shirred and his wife Sally E. for themselves their heirs executors and assigns
 doth hereby covenant and agree with the said Littlebury Mason that they will forever defend
 and defend the right and title to the above tract of land conveyed to the said Littlebury Mason
 his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims demand or demands of all persons or persons
 whatsoever in Witness whereof the parties have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed
 their seals the day and year above mentioned
