I Now all men by these presents that I Matthew Johnson of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia have for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty Seven dollars and Fifty Cents to me in Hand paid by Jacob Barnes of this place and County and date at and before the delivery and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have in right of my wife Betsy whose maiden name was Betsy Beck burgess sold granted and confirmed unto the said present bargainer full grant and confirm to the said Jacob Barnes all the right title interest and estate now or heretofore to accrue to me by the marriage of the said Betsy to me and from a devise made to myself wife Betsy by one Henry Bellom his last will and testament which witness of record in the Clerk's Office for the County of Bertieford in the State of North Carolina To have and to hold the said legacy bequeathed as aforesaid with all the charge and profits of the same which have or shall accrue from or by the said Legacy to him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the 17<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine.

Deed of Sale This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 1830 between Samuel Drury of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and James E. Newson of the said County known also and State of the second part. And Alexander P. Peete of the said County and State of the third part. Whereas the said James E. Newson on the several day of May 1829 executed to secure the payment of the sum of Six Thousand and sixty six dollars to the said Alexander P. Peete did by Indenture of first of that date convey to the said Samuel Drury his heirs and assigns of the following property (town) one certain tract or parcel of Land situated in the County aforesaid bounded by the lands of James E. Peters John Myrick and others containing two hundred acres the same more or less upon trust for the uses and purposes in the said Indenture mentioned and whereas since the executing and delivering of the said Deed of Trust the said Newson hath fully satisfied and paid the said Peete the several sum of money therby secured which the said Peete doth hereby acknowledge. Now this Presente witnesseth that for the consideration aforesaid as well as for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Newson to the said Drury at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge I do the said Drury with the assent and approbation of the said Peete signified by his being party to these presents and the said Peete having granted bargained and sold remised released and confirmed and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell to me release and confirm unto the said Drury all the Estate right title and interest claim and demand both at Law and in Equity which the said Drury or Peete have or hold in the land above named to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land to the said Newson his heirs Executors and assigns forever. To the only proper use and behoof of him the said Newson his heirs Executors and assigns in a full and ample manner as the same was given unto by the said Newson by the said Peete above recited to warrant the
