Dury This Indenture made this 12<sup>th</sup> day of March in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
thirty between Robert G Simmons and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton of whom part is  
Seph Drury of the aforesaid County of the other part witnesseth that the said Robert G Simmons and  
Elizabeth his wife in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Pounds and Sixty two dollars lawful money  
of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Seph Drury as or before the ensuing  
delivery of these presents have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto  
the said Seph Drury his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land situated in  
the County of Southampton containing by recent survey four hundred and thirty seven acres more or less  
and bounded as follows beginning at a post oak on the Cedar Point road a corner of Edward Pitt's  
stone Easterwardly to a corner in Ethelreda Bratton's line thence to an oak in Cromwell's field thence  
to a white oak on the road at the head of the Great Horse Branch thence down the said branch to  
gum tree the long ground of the Brambley Swamp thence South to an oak in Cromwell's field  
line thence West to the head of said Swamp thence up the said Swamp to Edward Pitt's  
line thence to the road and down said road to the beginning together with all the rights  
the appurtenances to the said land belonging and the reversion and remainder remaining  
and remunerated yearly and other rents ipsius and profits and of every kind and present then
