 hundred and thirty between Jesse Drury of the first part John Dick of the second part and John Deneque
 Robert G. Simmons Zebulon Simmons and Alexander Briggs of the third part all of the County of Southampton
 and State of Virginia. Whereas the said John Deneque Robert G. Simmons Zebulon Simmons and Alex-
 ander Briggs stand bound as security for the said Jesse Drury for the administration of his father
 Samuel Drury dec'd executor and the said Jesse Drury being residing and desirous to secure the said
 John Deneque Robert G. Simmons Zebulon Simmons and Alexander Briggs from any damage they
 may or likely may sustain in consequence of being his security as aforesaid Now this Indenture Wit-
 neth that for and in consideration of the premises and also the further consideration of one dollar to
 the said Jesse Drury in hand paid by the said John Dick at and before the sealing and delivery of
 these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Jesse Drury he has given
 granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant
 bargain sell alien enfeoff release and confirm to the said John Dick his heirs and assigns forever
 all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton in the State of
 Virginia containing by recent survey 47 acres more or less and bounded as follows Beginning
 at a great oak on the labor point road a corner of Edwards White Stone thence Eastwardly to a
 corner in Etchard Drake's line thence to an oak in Shumard's line thence to a white oak on the
 road at the head of the Great Run branch thence down said branch to a gum tree in the
 road of the offcamp place thence South to an oak in Shumard's line thence West to the
 said offcamp place thence up the said offcamp to Edward Butler's line thence to the road and down said
 road to the beginning with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of land
