This Indenture made and executed this 15th day of March One thousand Eight hundred and
thirty between Melcha Williams of the one part and Edward Crompler of the other part both of them of
Southampton County and State of Virginia witnesseth that whereas the said Melcha Williams doth
for and in consideration of the sum of Forty five dollars to her in hand paid at and before the sealing &
and delivering of these presents by her the said Edward Crompler the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged grant bargained sell and Confer with the said Edward Crompler his heirs and assigns
for ever one certain tract and parcel of Land Containing by survey summa half acres to being a
part of the tract of Land wherein the said Melcha Williams now dwelt And the same also a part
of the tract of Land the said Melcha Williams derived from her Husband to wit Mr. Melcha
Williams living and being in the County of Southampton and in the lower part of Notomay Parish bounded
as follows viz. Beginning at a pine a men corner between the said Melcha Williams
and Edward Crompler thence 70 M along a run line of markes thene thence aforesaid Melcha
and Crompler 28 poles 10 M to a pine austram corner between the said Melcha Williams &
Edward Crompler in More than 100 land line thence 268 E 12 p to a pine in the hollow side of a stone
S 27 E along the said line 12 p to another pine thence S 22 1/2 E along the said line 10 poles to
a brook com. in the hollow of the Fox Trap branch running down the sum of the said branch the
various courses thereof 57 p to a white oak a corner between More than 100 land Edward Crompler
and Melcha Williams & 34 p 88 along the old line between Melcha Williams and Edward Crompler
her 10 p to an old pine stump thence N 49 W along the said line 11 p to a spruce pine then west
31 1/2 M along the said line 21 p to a dead pine thence N 38 W along the said line 11 p to a dead
oak stump thence 48 M along the said line 19 p 10 M to the pine the beginning of Melcha and
