

Norfolk This Indenture made and entered onto the 11th day of March one thousand Eight hundred and thirty between Nathaniel Newsome and Narsapa his wife of the one part and Aunt Elanias of the other part all of the County of Southampton Parish of St. Peter's and State of Virginia W^m testified that the said Nathaniel Newsome and Narsapa his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars to them paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Nathaniel Newsome and Narsapa his wife have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed unto the said Aunt Elanias and to her heirs and assigns forever all the proportion of the tract of Land which was assigned as Dower to Elizabeth Barron widow of the late Henry Barron dec^d now the wife of the said Aunt Elanias and to whom she is due in title Narsapa Newsome formerly Narsapa Barron being one of the distributees of the said Henry Barron dec^d being one fourth part thereof and containing by estimation four hundred acres more or less one fourth of which it is hereby intended to be conveyed by us the said Nathaniel Newsome and Narsapa his wife to the said Aunt Elanias and to her heirs and assigns forever in reversion after the death of her said wife is determined. To have and to hold the said one fourth of the said Tract containing one hundred acres more or less it being the entire right title interest and claim of the said Newsome Wife to any and every portion of the said Tract together with all the improvements now and hereafter made and to be made belonging to the said Aunt Elanias her heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of them the said Aunt Elanias her heirs and assigns forever And the said Nathaniel Newsome and Narsapa his wife do for themselves and their heirs covenants and agree with the said Aunt Elanias her heirs and assigns that they the said Nathaniel Newsome and Narsapa his wife their heirs Executors shall and do hereby warrant and forever defend the title and reversionary rights in the above mentioned Land and promised unto the said Aunt Elanias her heirs and assigns forever against the claims of all persons what and where In Testimony whereof we the said Nathaniel Newsome and Narsapa his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day & Year first above written
