This Indenture made and entered into this 19 day of February one thousand eight hundred and thirty in and between John G. Miller of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Sepe Gardner of the same County and State of the second part, and Sepe Parker of the same County and State of the third part. Witnesseth that whereof the said John G. Miller stands specially indebted unto James Charles come in the first and full sum of one hundred and ten dollars current money of Virginia which appears by bond bearing date with these presents made payable from this date availing on bond bearing date the 15 day of April 1830 for the sum of Eleven dollars and Sepe Gardner become his security for the above sum. Now the said John G. Miller being desirous to indemnify and secure the above named Sepe Gardner his security shop his money and daily for the sum of one dollar to him, the said John G. Miller in hand paid by the said Sepe Parker and the before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John G. Miller that the said John G. Miller hath granted bargained and sold and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell to him the said Sepe Parker his heirs and assigns forever one negro woman a young one boy Elias one attorney Lewis and all my household and Kitchen Furniture and 6 1/2 acres of land to the same more or less to him the said Sepe Parker his heirs and assigns forever upon the following Terms to wit that if the said John G. Miller shall first pay and discharge the above mentioned debt and all costs pertaining to this debt it shall be lawful and right in that event for him with said Sepe Parker so soon as requested in writing from him the said Sepe Gardner his heirs or assigns to determine and sell for cash the above mentioned property after giving Public Notice by advertisement to be set up at different places in the neighborhood of the said John G. Miller at least fifteen days before the day of sale and out of the money so raised to first pay the above mentioned debt and all costs pertaining to this debt and the surplus if any pay over to the said John G. Miller his heirs or assigns In Testimony the above named property is to remain in possession of the said John G. Miller until called for by the trustee in writing when of the parties have set in hand and seals this day and year first above written

Witnesseth that the said John Barrett and Margaret his wife in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Mary Stille at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Mary Stille her heirs and assigns All our intent in the donor lands of the said Mary Stille to bring the two shares the said John Barrett bought of Richard Stille sold on of John Stille to bring the two shares the said John Barrett bought of Richard Stille given Stille with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging To have and to hold the said land with the tenements her appurtenances and all and singular other the promised herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Mary Stille her heirs and assigns forever To and for the only proper use and behoof of the said Mary Stille Whom she has named for ever and the said John Barrett and Margaret his wife for themselves and their heirs the
