Doyal Griffin Esq of said Wick with Anthony Halls Security and in order to secure the said bond
for my husband's security gave to him a deed of Trust on said land and other property and Allen
Edward was Trustee in said deed and the said Drake did not satisfy said debt and in
order to indemnify the said Halls the said Allen Edward as Trustee did sell to the highest
bidder after giving due notice of the same the said Land and David Doyal became
the purchaser Not this Indenture Witnesseth that on the 12th day of November 1829
that the said Allen Edward for a consideration of fifty dollars of lawful money of the State
to him in hand paid by the said David Doyal at or before the sealing and delivering of this
present the receipt whereof is acknowledged I have bargained and sold and by these presents
do bargain and sell unto David Doyal one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being
within the County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a small pond
on James Jenkins line north near the road thence South by a line of marked trees between
the said Jenkins to the corner thence S. E. a line of marked trees to the corner thence S. and
a marked tree between Draper to the Quarter road thence up the said road to the beginning
containing by estimation twenty five acres more or less together with all the buildings thereon
Land hereunto wood ways water way & privilege of profits common with the same
appurtenant and which over to the thirty five acres of land belonging or in any way
appertaining or with the same use & enjoyment as belonging to the same or any part
thereof I do have and to hold the said thirty five acres of land with the Tenements and
and singular or their premises herebefore mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold
and every part and parcel thereof with his right as Trustee unto the said David Doyal his
heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use of him the said David Doyal the
heirs and assigns forever and the said Allen Edward and his heirs the said thirty five acres
