Witnesseth that whereas the said Henry Johnson stands justly indebted unto the said Wells Murfee in the sum of twenty five dollars lawfully owing of Virginia which appears by a certain date the 25 day of February 1830 and made payable from date then the said Henry Johnson being desirous to secure the payment thereof but more especially for the sum of one dollar to him the said Henry Johnson in hand paid by Simon Murfee at or before the ending and delivery of this indenture the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged with grant bargain and sell unto the said Simon Murfee and by these presents has granted bargain and sold unto the said Simon Murfee his heirs and assigns forever 2 Chests 6 sitting Chairs 2 pine Tables 2 Iron pots 1 Spinning wheel 1 Spade 4 Sticks 1 bridle and saddle one gun 9 plates 2 dishes 2 basons 9 Shovel one frying pan 3 combs 2 Tubs 2 Pails 2 Craggins 1 Coffee pot 2 Trays 3 bags 1 pair of long and shovels 1 pair of shears and all other contents of a bed and the said Henry Johnson are now possessed of
