This Indenture made this 4th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between Marthe D Ford of the one part and Henry Snorn of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Marthe D Ford for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars in her hand paid by the said Henry Snorn the receipt whereof the said Marthe D Ford doth hereby acknowledge herself fully satisfied and paid and of the same doth by these presents acquit the said Henry Snorn the said Marthe D Ford hath granted bargained and sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant buy and sell alien convey and confirm unto the said Henry Snorn his heirs and assigns forever all the right title interest claim and demand which the said Marthe D Ford had here before or hereafter may lawfully have and to a certain undivided tract of Land lying in the County of Southampton and State aforesaid and bounded as follows by lands formerly Barrens Joseph Mecke for George Peter Pierce and others being the same plantation or tract of Land whereunto Ford and his wife Mary did sell and dispose of and which was severed by Henry Snorn to his daughter Mary and her heirs a deed is recorded in the office of the County Register being thence had many more fully appear thereto belonging in any manner claiming with the reversions and reversioners & assigns and remainders reversions and heirs thereof and every part and parcel thereof of the undivided tract within mentioned So these deeds hold unto the said Henry Snorn his heirs and assigns forever and the said Marthe D Ford for her self and her heirs heirs and assigns the said bargained and sold land & exempted from all claims or other demands and whatsoever into the said Henry Snorn his heirs and assigns against all and every person whatsoever doeth shall and will by these presents forever and to the end.
