This Indenture made this 4th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between Martha D. Ford of the one part and Henry Snom of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Martha D. Ford for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars unto her in hand paid by the said Henry Snom the receipt whereof the said Martha D. Ford doth hereby acknowledge herself fully satisfied and paid and of the same doth by these presents a receipt the said Henry Snom the said Martha D. Ford having granted bargained and sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell alien convey and confirm unto the said Henry Snom his heirs and assigns forever all the right title interest claim and demand which the said Martha D. Ford had here before or hereafter may have or have to a certain undivided tract of Land lying in the County of Southampton and State aforesaid and bounded as follows by lands formerly Barrens Joseph Micks John Demare Peter Pierce and others being the same plantation or tract of Land whereunto the said Martha D. Ford and his wife Mary did seized and possessed and which was severed by Henry Snom to his daughter Mary and her heirs a deed is recorded in the office of the County of Southampton being thence had many more fully appear thereto belonging in any manner claiming with the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders reversionary and every part and parcel thereof of the undivided tract within mentioned. So that she do hold unto the said Henry Snom his heirs and assigns forever and the said Martha D. Ford for her self and her heirs heirs and assigns the said bargained and sold land exempted from all claims or other incumbrances whatsoever unto the said Henry Snom his heirs and assigns against all and every person whatsoever do it shall and well by these presents forever warrant and defend.
