Naugham estate and Matthew Daughtry of Isle of Wright County and State of Virginia of the second and
part remanded by Vaughan of the same County and state of the third part witnesseth that whereas the said Lemuel
Daughtry doth pretty indebted unto the said Matthew Daughtry in the sum and full sum of
Matthew Lang Three hundred and twenty two dollars lawful money of Virginia which he yearly receives
by day the 20th date with these presents and made payable from the date thence of from the said Lemuel Daughtry
day of June 1830 sum remaining and due to him to secure the payment of the above debt but more especially
for the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by him the said Lemuel Vaughan before the
ensuing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged (R) that
the said Lemuel Daughtry hath granted bargains and sold and doth by these presents grant
bargain and sell to him the said Lemuel Vaughan his heirs and assigns forever the following
property fourth, one negroe man Daniel one woman Rose one woman Anna 2 Pines 2
Sheep off Cuck & 4 Head of Sheep 1 Barn 1 Stell and cedar works of various
my Crop of all kind my corn fields 100 bushels and all my Household and Kitchen furniture of
kind my farmy utensils of all kinds to him the said Lemuel Daughtry his heirs and assigns
for ever upon the following trust, 1832, that if the said Lemuel Daughtry shall fail to pay and
discharge the above mentioned debt and all costs pertaining to this trust it shall be lawful and right
in that event for him the said Lemuel Vaughan so soon requested in writing from him the said
Matthew Daughtry his heirs or assigns to set up and sell for and the before named property
after giving publick notice by advertising to be set up at different places in the neighborhood
of the said Lemuel Daughtry at least twenty days before the day of sale and out of the money
so raised first paying the above debt and all costs pertaining to this trust and the overplus of any
pay over to him the said Lemuel Daughtry his heirs or assigns In Testimony whereof the witness
