This Indenture made and entered into the 3^d day of March one thousand eight hundred and
 thirty in and between Lemuel Daugherty of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the first part
 and Matthew Daugherty of the County of Albemarle and State of Virginia of the second part Lemuel
 Daugherty of the same County and State of the third part Witnesseth that whereas the said Lemuel
 Daugherty stands justly indebted unto the said Matthew Daugherty in the just and full sum of
 fifteen hundred and twenty two dollars lawful money of Virginia which appears by Bond bearing
 date the 2^d of June with these presents and made payable from the date thereof To wit the said Lemuel Daugherty
 being willing and desirous to discharge the payment of the above debt and more especially
 for the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by him the said Lemuel Daugherty before the
 making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof as hereby acknowledged that
 the said Lemuel Daugherty hath granted bargained and sold and doth by these presents grant
 bargain and sell to him the said Lemuel Daugherty his heirs and assigns forever the following
 property to wit one negro man Daniel one woman Rose one woman Drivals 2 Horses &
 Grad 1/2 Cattle 4 Hides of Hogs 12 Head of sheep 1 Pound of Steel and cider works of all kinds
 my Crop of all kind my corn &c and all my household and kitchen furniture of all
 kind my farming utensils of all kind to him the said Lemuel Daugherty his heirs and assigns
 forever in full satisfaction of the debt aforesaid that if the said Lemuel Daugherty should die before the
 discharge the above mentioned debt and all costs pertaining to this deed it shall be lawful and legal
 on that event for him the said Lemuel Daugherty to demand and receive from him the said
 Matthew Daugherty his heirs and assigns to set up and sell for cash the before named property
 after giving public notice by advertising to do set up as different places in the neighborhood
 of the said Lemuel Daugherty at least twenty days before the day of sale and out of the money
 so raised first pay the above debt and all costs pertaining to this deed and the surplus if any
