This Indenture made this 16th day of April 1830 between Jacob Williams of the County
and William Williams of the same part Witnesseth that whereas one Elisha Williams
with his wife made a deed of Gift which has been duly recorded conveying to Edwrd Turner
in a former deed certain property which was to be conveyed absolutely to the said William
Williams upon the death of Elisha Williams and his wife Elizabeth Williams the said
Edwrd Turner being to whom the power was given by deed of conveying the property
did declare that of this County as provided in this place Jacob Williams with the same powers and
privileges as were granted to Edwrd Turner and the contingencies therein specified in the deed being
happened namely the death of Elisha Williams and his wife Elizabeth Williams did last of power
trust by this deed bearing date the day and year above mentioned convey the same and other
right conveyed to Edwrd Turner and by the said Afterward received in Jacob Williams
all the right title and interest whatsoever growing out of the following property to William
Williams and his heirs forever to their own and proper use Viz a tract of Land lying in the
County bounded by a swamp called Duckhorn more part by the land of Elisha Williams
another part and by the land of Thomas Foster on another containing in all
fourty four acres and also the following negroes Viz a Col. (Lycia was conveyed to
and Redina. Jacob Williams trustee doth convey by these presents the within interest
vested in him in the above named property to the said William Williams and his heirs
