said Giles Reese and Maney J Reese for and in consideration of the sum of
lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin Lamb whereof the debt being
acknowledged the receipt hath bargain sold and doth by these presents bargain and sell unto the
said Benjamin Lamb his heirs executors and administrators or assigns a parcel or tract of Land con-
taining by late survey two hundred and eighty one acres situate lying and being in the County
of Southampton and on the South side of Potomac River and being a part of the land sold by
the Trustees of the Potomac Tribe of Indians and known by Lot A 34 and bounded as follow: Viz
Beginning at a pine a new corner of Lot A 34 & 4. in Ridley's line thence N 52 1/2 E 94 pole thence N
25 1/2 E 34 pole thence N 20 pole thence N 44 E 88 pole thence N 18 1/2 S 2 pole to a white oak on the
Indian path thence the various meanders of Indian path to a pine a new corner on the Indian
path near the black pond thence S 65 1/2 E to a small Red oak a corner of Lot A 34 thence
due N 27 1/2 pole to the beginning of the same more or less Together with all the improvements
in or on the said land and appurtenances whatever unto the said tract or parcel of
in any wise appertaining or belonging to have and to hold the said tract lot or parcel of
