Wm. McNeal This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of April one thousand Eight hundred and thirty between I. McNeal  
 of the first part citizen of Virginia and James D. Bryant of the second part and William Bryant of the third  
 & Bryan Trustee all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that whereas the said citizen  
 & I. McNeal and James D. Bryant, both to come as security for the said John McNeal in a certain writing obligatorily being  
 to him equal date with these presents of the sum of Forty two dollars and twenty eight cents to Richard Seaver  
 carried the 10<sup>th</sup> whereas the said John McNeal is owing and deserves of bearing the said citizen to him  
 26<sup>th</sup> day of Bryan the above sum of Forty two dollars and twenty eight cents security aforesaid to him the sum  
 January 1832 further witnesseth that the said John McNeal hath for anson consideration of the sum of One dollar to

 of Cheese together with all my Proprietary, Corn fodder, Cotton press, Potatoes &c. To have and to hold  
 aforesaid property to him the said William Bryant his heirs and assigns to the uses proprie and intent  
 herein the said William Bryant his heirs and assigns forever upon the special trust and confinement aforesaid  
 and to and for the uses intent and purpose following that is to say that the said William Bryant may at any  
 time hereafter when he shall be required by either of the parties make due of the aforesaid property by, on his  
 Gun one saddle and to take one gun one large Pot one Gun one Gun one Gun one Gun one Gun one Gun one  
 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1832 may think proper so to render complete Justice to the parties at least ten days previous to the  
 day for ready money and one of the proceeds of such date may enter Harry C. Kindred and James D. Bryant
