 six shaves a spinning wheel and all the Crockery of which he is possessed at this date To have and
 hold the said things granted or intended to be granted unto the said Leticia R. Edwards her heirs
 Executors and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Leticia R. Edwards
 his heirs Executors and assigns forever and the said Henry Johnson for himself his heirs Executors
 doth hereby covenant promise and agree to and with the said Leticia R. Edwards his heirs Executors
 in manner and form following that is to say that the said Henry Johnson his heirs Executors and assigns
