request that the aforesaid property or such part as the Trustee or his representatives hereby authorized to act
shall think sufficient for the purpose and shall think proper to sell to the highest bidder for ready money
public auction after having fixed the time and place of sale at his own discretion and given ten days notice
therefor one or more of the most convenient places in the Town of New Haven and out of the Town
arising from such sale shall after satisfying the charge of time and all other expenses attending the premises
pay to the said Dr. L C T. Freeman & Co's agent their Executor administration or agents the said
sum of fifty dollars and six dollars & one cent and the balance if any shall pay to the said Dr. L C T. Freeman & Co's
agent their Executor administration or agents. But if the whole of the sum of Fifty six dollars and one cent
shall be fully paid off and discharged to the said Dr. L C T. Freeman & Co's agent their Executor
administration or before the 25th day of December 1830 when the same is payable so that no default of the payment
of the sum of Fifty Six Dollars & one cent can be made then this said clause to be void and

Now all men by these presents that I Thomas Abamson of Southampton County and State of Virginia
being indebted to William D'Alonoff of the County and State aforesaid in the just and full sum of one
hundred and twenty dollars am by note and dated the first day of May 1830 and being desirous as well
to secure the true payment thereof here as well for the aforesaid sum of one hundred and twenty dollars as
also one dollar to me in hand paid by the said John A. Person the trust which is hereby acknowledged
I the said Thomas Abamson have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and
sell unto the said John A. Person his heirs and assigns the following property to wit one barrel salt six
hds of hay the crop cotton com fodder and three barrels of bran the household and Kitchen furniture consisting
of beds &c etc two cedar peps and one applemill to have and to hold the aforesaid property as a
specie trust and contribution to the intent and purpose that is the aforesaid sum of one hundred and
twenty dollars shall remain unpaid to the said John A. Person his heirs or assigns shall after giving
ten days notice expose the aforesaid property to public sale at any time after the 25th day of December
next and with the money arising therefrom first to pay and satisfy the aforesaid sum of one hundred and twenty
dollars as also the expense attending the execution of this trust and the surplus of any sum to me may
henceforth &c. In Testimony we have hereunto set our hand and affixed our seals the 10th day
of May one thousand eight hundred and thirty.
