All that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in or upon and bounded as follows to wit by the Lands of Major Edward Bailey &c on the North on the East &c together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the heirs of the said Richard Boche his heirs and assigns of every and singular parts thereof and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the tenements hereunto and all singular other the promises herebefore mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Richard Boche his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas DeBach for himself and his heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances hereunto and unto the said Richard Boche his heirs or assigns free from the claim of him the said Thomas DeBach his heirs or assigns and of all and every person or persons whomsoever shall and lawfully and forever defend these presents.
