This Indenture made this 25th day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty five Between John T. Blor, Jacob Williams and Joseph Rude Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton to make sale of Land wherof the said John T. Blor did sue and his receipt of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and John T. Blor of the aforesaid County in State of the other part witnesseth that whereas the said John T. Blor, Jacob Williams and Joseph Rude for and in consideration of the sum of sixteen hundred dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said John T. Blor the receipt whereof the said John T. Blor, Jacob Williams and Joseph Rude do hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said John T. Blor his heirs executors and administrators and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell all in geoff and on from unto him the said John T. Blor the certain tract or parcel of Land wherein the said Alfred O'Donnell formerly lived containing by survey three hundred and twelve acres in the same more or less and bounded as followeth beginning at a red oak tree on the road leading from Lansdowne to Bethlehem Crossroad thence by a line of marked trees to a black Jack formerly a corner tree for Alfred O'Donnell deceased and Thomas Vaughan to die thence by a line of marked trees to a small sapling a corner tree for Albany T. Blor and thence Alfred O'Donnell thence by a line of marked trees to a pine near the road before mentioned thence up said road to the beginning To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and its appurtenances to the only proper use and behoof of him the said John T. Blor his heirs executors and assigns and they the said John T. Blor, Jacob Williams and Joseph Rude for themselves their heirs executors and assigns and with the said John T. Blor that they all warrant and forever defend the title to the above mentioned tract of Land to him the said John T. Blor his heirs and assigns forever against themselves their heirs executors and assigns and against all persons whomsoever. This Indenture Made this 18th day of March 1830 between Jordan Barnes of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Simmons Barnes of the County of Southampton and State of North Carolina of the second part. Collin Mc Barnes and James H. Wood of the County of Southampton and State of North Carolina of the other part. Whereas Jordan Barnes stands fully indebted unto the said Collin Mc Barnes in the sum of One hundred and Ninety nine dollars and Six cents due by Note bearing equal date with these presents and whereas the said Jordan Barnes stands fully indebted unto the said James H. Wood the sum of Four hundred and Eighteen dollars and thirty four cents due by Note bearing equal date with these presents and the said Jordan Barnes being willing and desirous to clear the payment of the before mentioned Bond unto the said Collin Mc Barnes and James H. Wood upon this Indenture witnesseth that the said Jordan Barnes in consideration of the premises and also for the further Consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by him the said Simmons Barnes the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted a bargain and sold to the said Simmons Barnes and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto him the said James Barnes his heirs executors and assigns the following property to wit Negro man Ned and Abram woman Lucy Colerett and Simmons girl Esther Linda Adams and Free and day George and thirty horses one Gray horse and one Sorrell Horse three bed and furniture to have and to hold the above mentioned property to him the said Simmons Barnes his heirs executors and assigns forever
