This Indenture made this 27th day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty
 between James Blairiston of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part
 Lewis Blairiston of the second part and Howell Blairiston of the third part Witness that whereas
 the said James Blairiston is justly indebted to the said Howell Blairiston in one certain obligation of money
 under the hand and seal of the said James Blairiston for the sum of Thirty one dollar and
 two cents on demand the 25th day of December 1830 which the said James Blairiston is
 unwilling to secure nor this Indenture Witness that for and in consideration
 of the premises also for the further consideration of one dollar lawful money of Virginia to the said
 James Blairiston in hand paid by the said Lewis Blairiston on or before the date hereinafter
 of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said James Blairiston delivery
 given granted bargained and sold with give grant bargain'd sell and Confin
 unto the said Lewis Blairiston his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying &
 being in the County and State aforesaid containing by estimation Ninety one and 1/2 the same more
 or less and bounded as follows by the lands of William & James Wrennham Esqrs. John Wrennham
 and George Gray with all and singular appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of Land
 belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said James Blairiston in and to the said granted
 tract or parcel of Land and promised to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of
 Land with its appurtenances him before mentioned unto the said Lewis Blairiston his heirs
 assigns forever and the same James Blairiston doth for himself his heirs Executors and assigns
 in Manus and Form following that to wit that the said James Blairiston his heirs Executors
 and assigns doth assign the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and promises with the appurtenances hereby
 conveyed unto the said Lewis Blairiston his heirs &c. against all other persons who shall come here
 and shall warrant and forever defend by these presents. upon trust and upon the express
 condition that if the said James Blairiston shall fail to make him actual payment of the aforesaid
 sum of Thirty one dollar and Ninety two cents on or before the 25th day of December next and thereafter
 and that may accrue thereon then in that case the said Lewis Blairiston his heirs at the request of the
 said Howell Blairiston shall after giving twenty days notice for said to sell to the highest bidder
 for cash Virginia money the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land hereinbefore mentioned and out of
 the moneys arising from such sale after satisfying all reasonable charges thereon and all the
 expended attending such sale pay to the said Howell Blairiston his heirs Executors and assigns
 the sum of Thirty one dollar and Ninety two cents with the interest which may thereon accrue
 and the balance if any pay to the said James Blairiston his heirs Executors and assigns. But if
 the whole sum of Thirty one dollar and Ninety two cents shall be fully paid off and discharged
 to the said Howell Blairiston his heirs Executors administrators and assigns on or before the 25th day
 of December next when the same is payable so that no default of payment of the said sum
 of Thirty one dollar and 92/100 cents be made then this Indenture to be void or else to remain
 in full force and virtue. Witness our hands of the said parties to this Indenture hereunto
