 Upon this Special Trust and Confidence Nevertheless yet that the said Richard A. Vreghart  
 shall will and the said Richard A. Vreghart his heirs and assigns do to do upon application  
 of the said John Vreghart James Vreghart and Thomas Gray or a majority so soon as they  
 have suffered by means of their said decemtyship or so soon as they may wish to close the said  
 transactions and relieve them from their said decemtyship after giving reasonable public  
 notice of the same to the above conveyed property or any part thereof that may be sufficient  
 upon such terms as they may think proper and of the proceeds first pay and satisfy to the  
 and each of the said parties so much as they may have paid by means of their said decemtyship  
 or to the said Bank or to the said Lewis N. Kiefer as the Case may be and the balance pay  
 to the said Thomas R. Gray and if there should be any deficiency to effect the said object  
 it is hereby expressed as the Contract of all the parties that the said John Vreghart James
