The Indenture made and executed the 31st day of May A.D. one thousand Eight hundred and thirty between Abram Lawrence of the first part and Simon Murphy and Elizabeth wife of the second part all living of the County of Southampton State of Virginia witnesseth that whereas the said Simon Murphy and Elizabeth his wife doth for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty eight dollars to him in hand paid by the said Abram Lawrence the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said Abram Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract of land containing by survey thirty nine and a half acres being a part of the David Edwards tract of land which was sold after his death under a deed of trust by James Edwards and Jerry Mathew Lewis pur chaser and Simon Murphy afterward bought it of them lying and being in the County aforesaid in the Town of Tappahannock and is bounded as follows. Beg. Beginning at a small red oak tree thence S 68° E to a small gum tree 93 1/2 p. S 68° E along a line of marked trees to a large pine tree 87 1/2 p. to a black gum tree 93 1/2 p.
