This Indenture made this fifteenth day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty Between Lathbury
Jones of the County of Southampton of the one part and Colmury Ellis and Robert Stephenson of the County of Sussex
Trustee of the other. Witnesseth that for and consideration of the sum of twenty dollars by and agreement
of Virginia hath bargain and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Colmury Ellis her
Car and wheels two Wags and all of my property of every kind and all my crop to the only proper use and
 behoof of him the said Colmury Ellis his heirs and assigns forever But the true intent and meaning of this
Indenture is that the said Lathbury Jones stands indebted to the said Colmury Ellis the sum of twenty
dollars current money of Virginia to be paid on or before the first day of May next ensuing and the said
Lathbury Jones in using the said sum of money should be paid unto the said Colmury Ellis his heirs or
Assigns if the said Lathbury Jones his heirs or Assigns do and shall well and truly pay pay or cause to be paid unto
the said Colmury Ellis his heirs or Assigns the above named sum of twenty dollars on or before the first day of May
next ensuing together all all contingent charges attending the same then the above Indenture be void and of no effect
but if the said sum of twenty dollars and the contingent charges attending the same shall not be paid on or before
the first day of May next ensuing then the above named Robert Stephenson may enter upon and possess the
above mentioned property and make sale thereof at public Auction for ready money or giving twenty days previous
notice and pay the said Colmury Ellis the sum above mentioned with lawful interest thereon to be paid
together with all contingent charges attending the same and the balance of any pay and deliver unto the said
