Articles of Agreement made and entered into this 15<sup>th</sup> day of December 1838 between George E Holmes  
of the Town of Jerusalem and County of Southampton of the one part and Robert Goodwin of the aforesaid  
County of the other part. Whereas it is agreed that the said George E Holmes and Robert Goodwin have  
mutually agreed the one with the other that the said George E Holmes shall and will cause to erect  
and build a good substantial framed wooden house suitable for a store house or Merchant's store  
And the said house shall be erected and built by him the said George E Holmes upon the land  
of him the said Robert Goodwin lying situated and being in the town of Jerusalem aforesaid  
that is to say upon any part of the front of the said lot between the Tavern now in the occu-  
pancy of A. T. Coker and the house now occupied by George Bryant as a saddlers shop but  
in such a manner as that the said house when erected shall stand immediately on the line between  
the said lot and the street running through the said town and shall not extend further back  
than shall be necessary for the dimensions and proper location of the same. But on the front line  
a sufficient space from the front to the rear of the said house for the free ingress and egress into  
and out of the and from the back apartments of the said stone house. And the said George E  
Holmes upon consideration of such promises and benefits granted to him by the said Robert  
Goodwin to locate and erect the said building upon the lot aforesaid doth covenant and agree to  
use the same in no way or manner by himself his heirs Execs or affigts as a Tavern or  
part of a Tavern for the space of Ten Years from the completion of said building and that the said  
Robert Goodwin in consideration of the said agreement of the said George E Holmes aforesaid
