This Indenture made this 24th day of May in the 30th year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty between Eliza Jones of the County of Southampton of the one part and John Denegre of the same County of the other part WITNESSETH that the said Eliza Jones for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred dollars of Lawful money of this Commonwealth to her in hand paid by the said John Denegre at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said John Denegre his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by recent survey according to the former surveyors report fifty seven acres more or less situated and lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows beginning at a Cedar a Corner of Thomas Pears's yard thence to a white oak thence following the meanders of the N Branch near the title lands to a staple corner tree between Mary & Licks land near the branch thence taking the meanders of the said branch down to John Denegre's line thence on the said line to a white oak corner tree between John Denegre and Henry Lenon thence a straight line up to Stoneburg and from the said road to the first station together with all the houses garden with all and singular the appurtenances and the curtilage and buildings & remainder and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said parcel of Land with the tenements hereunto and all and singular other the premises hereinbefore mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every their rights members and appurtenances unto the said John Denegre his heirs and assigns forever and the said Eliza Jones for herself and her heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John Denegre his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of her the said Eliza Jones and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall wish and do maintain and defend by these presents.
