the bounden duty of him the said Thomas Everitt his heirs or assigns to make sale of the above described
and hereby conveyed property at public Auction for Cash he first giving ten days previous public
notice of the time and place of such intended sale by advertisements posted up in at least three
public places in the aforesaid County of Southampton and of the Cash raised from and by such
sale just pay all reasonable expenses incurred in the execution of this Trust secondly pay the aforesaid
or so much thereof as may at any time appear to be due together with the legal interest thereon
thirdly and if surplused among thereafter remain the said Thomas Everitt his heirs or assigns
shall pay the same over to him the said Corby Whitfield or his legal representative the same
underwriting a release of any property left unsold of that which is herein hereby conveyed by

This Indenture made and entered into on the 11th day of August in the Year of our Lord one thou-
sand eight hundred and thirty by and between George Otis Sen of the first part Drury Drake of the
second part and Thomas Barnes of the third and last part each of the parties herein resident
of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia whereas the said George Otis stands
justly indebted to the said Thomas Barnes in the sum of seven dollars which debt appear-
ing due as well by bond of our date herewith as this Indenture itself the same being pay-
able and on demand the payment of which together with the legal interest accruing thereon the
said George Otis are willing and desirous effectually to settle and secure to the said Thomas
Barnes now therefore this Indenture Witnesseth that the said George Otis as well in
consideration of the premises as of the further sum of one dollar current money of the United
States to him in hand paid by the said Drury Drake at and before the making and deliv-
ery of these presents the full receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and from every part of
which the said Drury Drake and all his legal representatives are forever released exempted
and discharged he the said George Otis have as appears hereunto signed and do hereby
the said Drury Drake his heirs and assigns the following named property to wit those
