have lent and by these presents do lend unto the said Rebecca Rome during her natural life the follow-
ing property to wit: My Luke Tompkins and Nancy one Negro and Harriet one man and all the
one horse and shears one cow and her increase one chest of Carpenter's tools one shot Tom and all the
household and kitchen furniture which is at this time in the possession of her husband and William
Rome who said property I purchase of William Rome reference to the Clerk's Office of Pough-
keepsie County will more fully shew and the said William Rome his present husband & shall have no
power nor control over the same and it shall not be sold for the payment of any debt or debts which
the said William Rome now owes or may hereafter owe and after the death of my said sister
Rebecca Rome I desire all the aforesaid lent property shall be equally divided between all the
children which my said sister Rebecca Rome may have by her present husband William
Rome but if any of the said children should die before they arrive to the age of twenty one
years or leave no lawful heir of their body in that event the same money shall equally
divide his or her part between them I the said William H. Byrnum will forever maintain
and defend the same In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my

said Elisha Atkinson have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain
and sell to William Atkin one certain Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the
County aforesaid containing by estimation fourteen acres be the same more or less as follows
beginning in the Rades Swamp at the mouth of the Saw Branch
and thence along the said Branch to the fork and thence up the North Fork of the said
Branch to the land of Drury Little and thence along down the said Little's line to the
said Rades Swamp And thence along the said Swamp to the Beginning and all Elisha
right title claim and demand whatsoever of him the said Elisha Atkinson of in to the
same or any part thereof To have and to hold the said Tract or parcel of Land and
