Thorpe This Indenture made and entered into on the sixth day of August in the Year of our Lord one
Thousand Eight hundred and thirty Between Emma Thorpe and Polly Thorpe both of
Bonne the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Samuel Brown of the same County
and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Emma Thorpe has etc for and
in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars current money of the Commonwealth
to them in hand paid by the said Samuel Brown at or before the making and delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold alighted
enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents they and each of them the said Emma Thorpe and
Polly her wife doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Samuel
Brown his heirs and assigns forever One certain Tract or parcel of Land Situate bying and lying
in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Luke Containing by old Survey One
hundred and seven acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a white
oak standing on the south side of the road leading from Clark's Church to Munro's corner
for the land of said Emma and Joshua Thorpe in Survey Walling's line thence along said
Thorpe's line a N. Easterly Course to a Black gum a Corner for said Emma and Joshua Thorpe
and Benjamin Whifield thence along said Benjamin Whifield's line a North Westerly
Course to a red oak a Corner in said Whifield's line thence an Easterly Course to a pine a
corner for said Samuel Brown in said Benjamin Whifield's line thence along said Samuel
Brown's line a Southly Course to the Centre of the aforesaid road thence up the Centre of
the said Road to the Beginning together with all right betterment claim or demand
of in and to the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the aforesaid tract
or parcel of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereunto belonging
and all manner wood trees and other growing whatever belonging thereto
unto him the said Samuel Brown his heirs and assigns forever and the said Emma Thorpe
and Polly her wife for themselves their heirs etc and assigns hereby covenant and agree
to and with the said Samuel Brown his heirs Executors adms and assigns that they will
by these presents remain and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid
