*Remorseful to Battle*  
 This Indenture made this 16<sup>th</sup> day of August 1830 between Richard Barnes and his wife Martha D. of the one part and William R. Battle of the other part all of the County of Hertford and State of North Carolina Witnesseth that we the said Richard Barnes and wife Martha D. for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred and fifty dollars to us in hand paid or deemed to be paid by the said William R. Battle the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said William R. Battle his heirs and assigns store out of land to wit Lots 1-3 Lot 4 & 5 and Lot 6 & 7 containing by a late survey seventy nine acres more or less lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded by the State Line and Potomac River which said land formerly belonged to Esq. Battle dec. and was divided amongst his heirs under a decree of the County Court of Southampton in the Year 1829 as well more fully appear by reference to the report of the Commissioners in the Clerk's Office of the County of Southampton together with all the right title interest claim or demand which we or may have at the death of Esq. Battle in the above land which was allotted to her under the said decree for and during her natural life containing sixty five acres the said report will give the respective boundaries and number of each Lot To have and to hold the said land unto the said William R. Battle his heirs and assigns forever And we the saids Richard Barnes wife Martha D. will for ourselves our heirs Executors Administrators Reliance and forever defend the aforesaid Land unto the said William R. Battle his heirs and assigns from and against any person or persons claiming by through or under us and from and against all and any other person or persons whatsover unto the said William R. Battle his heirs and assigns forever And we the saids Richard Barnes and wife Martha D. have covenanted and agree to and with the said William R. Battle that we have got right and lawful authority to sell and Convey as aforesaid the said land and premises with their appurtenances thence belonging unto the said William R.
