This Indenture made this 23rd day of April 1830 Between Susan Abeline of the County of Southampton of the first part John Jared of the County of Suffolk of the second part and both Abelines of the County of Suffolk of third part witness the said Susan Abeline justly indebted to the said John Jared by note executed by the said Susan Abeline to John Bain for the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars payable 21st day of April 1831 and due 21st of April 1830 and which said note is regularly aforesaid by the said Bain to the said John Jared and which aforementioned bears even date with this deed and the said欠者 being willing and desirous of securing the said sum of money to the said John Jared had as well for the premises of one said as for the further consideration of one dollar to her by the said Joseph Jared before the ensaing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to have granted by said John and deliver to the said Joseph Jared his his Executors administrators and assigns forever the following slaves Eliz. Tom a Boy about 10 years old & Betty a girl about fifteen years old To have and to hold the said slaves to the only proper use and service of him the said Joseph Jared his his Executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Susan Abeline for herself his his Executors administrators the right and title to the said slaves unto the said Joseph Jared his his Executors administrators and assigns against the claim of herself or against his claim of any other person shall and will forever remane and defend by these presents Upon this point left it is the true intent and meaning of these presents that if the said Susan Abeline his his Executors or administrators shall fail to pay to the said Joseph Jared the amount of the debt said at the time aforesaid then it may and shall be lawful for the said Joseph Jared as he sees fit to sell to the highest bidder for cash so many of the aforesaid slaves as shall be sufficient to satisfy the debt interest and costs and out of the debt aforesaid pay the amount of the debt aforesaid together with any costs which may have accrued in carrying these slaves effect and the surplus if any pay over to the said Susan Abeline his his Executors with one of the parties hereinbefore set down and seals the day and year last written signed sealed and delivered
