the Trustee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged by the said John Drake hath given granted bargain and sold aliened conveyed
released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien convey release
and confirm to the said William McCulloh his heirs and assigns forever the following parcel
property to wit One Black Horse by the name of Dick one Chestnut horse named by the name
