

We do hereby commit the tuition education and Guardianship of said Orphan to you the said Thomas B. Glade. (upon appointing thereof by the acceptance of these letters thereunto bearing upon that appointment her in meat drink clothing and lodging that you consider to be necessary in such manner as shall be suitable to her interest and circumstances and that you acquiesce and take charge of her Estate both real and personal and all other things do which by Law you ought to do for you said Orphan. A true and perfect account of all which you shall render to the Court of Ordinary on the first Term in every year during your continuance of Office and you do hereby constitute and appoint you the said Thomas B. Glade Guardian of the said Orphan during her minority. In Testimony whereof I have officially set my hand and seal this 9 day of December 1839. and 54th Year of American Independence

Virginia Southampton County August 30th 1830

This is to certify that I have this day by virtue of a power of Attorney executed to me by the Guardians of the Infant Children of Richard Harris dec. of the State of Virginia bearing date the 14th of June 1830 and which is to be recorded in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Southampton and State of Virginia had a settlement with Peter Edwards administrator of Nathan Harris dec. of his transactions upon the estate of the deceased and that upon a full settlement of the same there appears to be due from the said Estate to the said Infant Children by name Nathan Nancy Thomas D. Edwin P. and Elizabeth Harris as their proportion of said Estate the sum of Three thousand two hundred and thirteen dollars and thirty cents including their negro slaves to wit Tom Henry and Henry valued at seven hundred dollars and thereby virtue of the said power of Attorney I have received the said amount in full discharge of all claims which the said infants as heirs and distributees of the said Nathan Harris have against his Estate and I do hereby by virtue of the power vested in me by the aforesaid power of Attorney forever discharge and acquit the said Peter Edwards from all demands which the said infants or those claiming under them may set up against him on account of his administration upon the estate of the said Nathan Harris.
