

Virginia Southampton County August 30th 1830

Recd of Richard Harris his day by virtue of a Power of Attorney from the Guardians of the infant child Charles Edward son of Richard Harris dec'd the sum of one hundred and forty five dollars and twenty three cents in full discharge of a Bond executed by him to William H. Lee, Nathaniel Rockelle and William Sudkins commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton to sell the Land belonging to Richard Harris dec'd and which is the proportion which the said infants are entitled to receive as appears by the Report of the said Commissioners filed with the suit of Harris and others against Peter Edwards administrator of a certain estate execrated which said Bond is dated the 17th of May 1830 and made payable on or before the 15th of May 1831 and was freely authorized and required the said Commissioners to deliver up the said Bond to the said Richard Harris at Wm Lee's office Hand and Seal the day and year first above written

The Receipt was proved by the oath of Nathaniel Cott and William C. Parker the
Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded

Whereas I this day made and returned into this 17th day of September 1830 to John Rice B. Price
and Frances his wife of the County of Halifax and State of North Carolina of the one part and Nathaniel
Rockelle of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part witnesseth
that the said Rice B. Price and Frances his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Sixteen
Hundred dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted
Bargained sold and confirmed and do by these presents grant bargain sell and confirm unto the
said Nathaniel Rockelle his heirs and assigns One certain tract and lot of Land lying and
being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and which the said Price doth bear
of Francis Edwards Martha Williamson and others being their distribution share in the division
of the lands of Lawrence Cott dec'd called and known by the name of the Machim Lot as aforesaid
more fully appear by reference to the Report of Commissioners dividing said Land and which said
Land is adjoining the lands of Britain Bryant and Henry Edwards Containing by Survey Two
Hundred and Eighty Eight Acres To have and to hold the said granted and Bargained Land and premises
with all and singular the rights privileges and improvements thereon within the said Rockelle's hands
and a assigns forever and the said Rice B. Price and Frances his wife for themselves their heirs &
assigns forever quit all claim in and to the aforesaid land and premises unto the said Rockelle
his heirs & assigns against the claim of whom the said Price and Frances his wife their heirs &c
and the said Rice B. Price and Frances his wife doth further covenant and agree to and with the said
Rockelle his heirs &c that they will forever warrant and defend all their right title and interest
in and to the said Land and premises unto the said Rockelle his heirs &c against the claim and
demands of whom the said Price and wife or any other person or persons claiming by them
or under them In witness of which the bonds to these presents have been countersigned their names
and affixed thereto shall the day and date first above written
