sum of one hundred dollars on demands and for value recd And whereas the said Lazarus Johnson willing
and desirous to secure the debt due to the said William Lawrence Nor therefore the said
and Johnson for and in consideration of the premises But more especially for and in consideration
of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Mills E Lawrence at or before the ensingangs
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Lazarus Johnson doth hereby acknowledge
having bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant and sell unto the said
Mills E Lawrence his heirs and assigns for the following purpose to wit one tract of Land lying
and being in the County of Southampton and Comt as follows as is expressed in a Deed of
Conveyance executed by the said Mills Griffin to the said James of Cowraugh for the sum of
Land together with all houses or lands woods ways and watercourses unto the said Land lying
in any wise appertaining what soever unto the said Mills E Lawrence his heirs and assigns
for ever but upon this special trust and condition that the said Mills E Lawrence his
Executor and admr shall proceed to sell at public sale the aforesaid land and plantations
above mentioned at any time when required by the said William Lawrence his heirs
and assigns for the last best price that can be obtained for the said Land of twelve
ten days previous and public notice shall be given by an advertisement in writing at any
public place in said County and proceed of such sale first pay unto the said William Lawrence

thereon and all cost and charges which may attend the said sale and then pay over the rest
