And if the said Nicholas shall will and truly conform the Contract and Covenants aforesaid and title to be given to said W<sup>m</sup> so that the said W<sup>m</sup> suffer no loss or injury then the above obligation to be given and said indenture to run and in full force and virtue. This Indenture made this twentieth day of September one thousand eight hundred and thirty between Eli Drake of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part James Peckell of the County and State of the second part and Joseph Peckell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of or said of the third part W<sup>m</sup> of both that to w<sup>m</sup> the said Eli Drake stands justly indebted by a note of hand to the said James Peckell in the sum of twenty six and twenty four cents current money of the United States of America and whereas for the further assurance of the payment of this note by the parties hereto that a conveyance in Trust shall be made unto the said Joseph Peckell for the benefit of the said James Peckell of the sum on the note aforesaid shall not be lawfully paid until with lawful interest thereon on or before the first day of December next at or which the said W<sup>m</sup> of both that the said Eli Drake for and in consideration of the premises and for the further sum of One dollar to him in hand paid the receipt of which is acknowledged hath conveyed and sold and by these presents doth for himself his heirs Executors and assigns sell unto the said Joseph Peckell his heirs and assigns on horse fairs Cattle mares hogs and all their increase the greater Beds and Furniture one Cart & pair of Cart wheels & three other stable one safe & four iron pot & hoes & Fry pan 3<sup>rd</sup> hoes 2 axes 2 w<sup>m</sup> hoes 1 w<sup>m</sup> wheel To have and to hold the aforesaid granted and conveyed premises unto the said Joseph Peckell his heirs and assigns in Trust however and it is hereby declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents that if the said Eli Drake shall have actually paid to the said James Peckell his heirs or assigns the said sum of twenty six dollars and twenty four cents and interest agreeable to the terms of the said note to the said James Peckell then the said Joseph Peckell his heirs and assigns shall hold the property above granted to the sole and proper use and behoof of the said Eli Drake And the said Joseph Peckell covenants and agrees with the parties hereto that if the said Eli Drake his heirs Executors and assigns shall fail to make payment to the said James Peckell his heirs and assigns on or before the first day of December next the sum due on the note aforesaid then the said Joseph Peckell his heirs and assigns shall have the right of the above granted and conveyed premises for the purposes following that is to say at the request of the said James Peckell his heirs or assigns the said Joseph Peckell his heirs Executors and assigns or either of them shall give ten days notice and sell at public auction the above mentioned property and shall pay the money arising therefrom to the said James Peckell his heirs or assigns to be for forth as shall be then due and as if said
