This Indenture made the third day of September in the 19th year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty Between Elisha Darden of the one part and William Lawrence of the other both of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia Witnesses that the said Elisha Darden for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said William Lawrence at or before the undersigned delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Elisha Darden hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said William Lawrence his heirs or assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and lying on the West side of the road leading from South Quay to Monroe Beginning at a Black gum standing on the said road a corner on the line of the late Henry Barton a.c. thence S 25° W 24 poles to a pine corner thence S 35° E 114 poles to a pine corner thence S 25° E a line of iron marked trees 83 p. to a line road and diverging at the aforesaid road thence along the road the various courses thence 135 poles to the beginning containing fifty acres more or less the reversion & reversions & remainder and to command & convey and their heirs and assigns thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises therein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto the said William Lawrence his heirs & assigns forever And the said Elisha Darden for himself and his heirs the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises & appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William Lawrence his heirs and assigns free from the claim of him the said Elisha Darden his heirs and assigns and of all and every other person or persons whatsover shall use and do or arrange and for and against these presents In Witness whereof the said Elisha Darden hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year as first above written
