Willis in a certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton at being the same tract of land soherne of John Willis of the said County did also and leases to her during her life or until her death. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises and every part thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Robert Nicholson and to his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Mary H. Willis for herself and her said the said tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances to the said Robert Nicholson to him and assigns shall and will warrant and defend against the claim of every person whatsoever claiming under her. Rochelle Esq. This Indenture made and entered into this the 16th day of September A.D. 1830 Between James S. Rockelle and Robert Goorwin of the first and Joseph Drury of the other part witnesseth that the said James S. Rockelle at the request of the said Joseph Drury and by and with the consent of the said Robert Goorwin signified by his being a party to this Deed, hath remitted released and forever quit claim and by these presents doth renounce release and forever quit claim and release to the said Joseph Drury his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing twenty and more or less being the last tract of land conveyed by the said Joseph Drury to the said James S. Rockelle trustee for the purpose of securing the payment of Debt due to the said Robert Goorwin by the said Drury till the 19th of August 1829 and duly recorded in Southampton County Court-house and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto him the said Joseph Drury his heirs and assigns forever against the claim and demand of them the said James S. Rockelle and Robert Goorwin their heirs and assigns. And the said James S. Rockelle for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators hereby covenants and agrees to and with the said Joseph Drury that he will for ever maintain and defend such title as is vested in him by the said Deed aforesaid in the said tract of land and the other title to him the said Joseph Drury his heirs and assigns forever.
