

by Indenture bearing date the 39th day of July in the year one thousand seven hundred and forty nine con-
taining by estimation Eighty six and a half acres to the same more or less. Situate lying and being in the County
of Southampton and State of Virginia of record and bounded as follows viz. Beginning at a post or standing
mark the run of the Ocean Gulf Branch a corner tree in Skinner's line running along the said
Branch Joseph Evans line to an oak a corner tree in said Skinner's line from thence
Joseph's line then running along said Joshua Evans line to a pine a corner tree in Archibald Scott's
line then along said Archibald to the Horse Bone Branch thence down the several courses of
the run of the said Branch to the mouth of a small Branch and up the run of the same to a
white oak corner tree thence a straight course to a pine a corner tree James Scott's line running
the said Scott's line to the beginning also all the buildings whatsoever material advantages
and appurtenances to the same in any wise belonging and the services recommended unto him
and his heirs and all the Estate right and title of him the said Ridley Drake of and to
the same also for feather beds and furniture one hundred and twelve dollars Eighteen shillings
chairs with all the residue of my household furniture and all my kitchen furniture and
plantation implements To have and to hold the above granted and bargained premises with
every of the appurtenances unto the said Joseph Tilton his heirs and assigns in Trust forever And
is hereby declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents that if the said Ridley Drake
shall punctually pay to the said James Scott his heirs or assigns the said sum of Sixty three dollars
and Ninety three Cents and interest agreeable to the terms of the said Note of hand to the said James Scott
then the said Joseph Tilton his heirs and assigns shall hold the said lands good and chattels above
granted to the sole and proper use and behoof of the said Ridley Drake. And the said Joseph
Tilton covenants and agrees with the parties herein that if the said Ridley Drake his heirs and
administrators shall fail to make payment to the said James Scott his heirs and assigns
before the first day of December next the sum due on the Note of hand of record that then the
said Joseph Tilton his heirs and assigns shall stand and be liable of the above grants and bargains and
for the purposes following that is to say that at the request of the said James Scott his
heirs Executors administrators or assigns the said Joseph Tilton his heirs Executors administrators
assigns or other of them shall give ten days Notice and call at publick sale the above mentioned
lands goods and chattels and shall pay the money arising therefrom to the said James Scott
his heirs Executors or assigns so far forth as shall be then due and after delivering the said
Note and interest with all the expenses remaining or arising from the said sale shall pay
the surplus money to the said Ridley Drake or his assigns In Witness whereof the parties

for and in consideration of the premises and also for the sum of one dollar to the said John J. Blon and
Elizabeth his wife by the said John R. Williams at and before the date and delivery of this
present the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John J. Blon and Elizabeth his wife
