

Cooper swrps

This Indenture made and entered into the 20th day of September Eighteen hundred and thirty six between  
 No James Cooper and Braminta his wife of the County of Southampton of the first part Robert Birchell Jr. of the  
 Second part and Brinsford Brown and Harry Harris of the third part Whereas the said Birchell Jr. doth  
 Relieve to Harry Harris Standbome for the said Cooper as Securitie of Richardat Gilliam orphan of Joseph Gilliam  
 R. Birchell Jr. deceased And whereas Brinsford Brown is also bound as security for the said Cooper as Securitie  
 Apr 6 1833 of Joseph P. Gilliam orphan of the said Joseph Gilliam deceased And whereas the said Cooper  
 desirous effectually to secure and have charmed them the said Brinsford and Harris from all loss or damage  
 by reason of their securityship aforesaid This Indenture therefore witnesseth that as well for and in  
 consideration of the premises of the sum of one dollar to the said Cooper and Braminta his wife in hand  
 paid by the said Robert Birchell Jr. before the sealing and delivery of these presents she nowe whose is  
 hereby acknowledged they the said James Cooper and Braminta his wife have given granted bargained  
 and sold and by these presents do give grant Bargain and sell and Convey unto the said Robert Birchell Jr.  
 the following property to wit One certain parcel of land Situate in the County of Southampton aforesaid  
 bounded by the lands of Edwin W. Coland and the other land held by the wife of Fullerton Mason on the land  
 on the East by the land of Benjamin Williams on the South by the John Clark and on the West by  
 the lands which were allotted to Edith daughter of the late James Harris and now owned by Braminta  
 wife of the said James Cooper Containing three hundred and twenty seven acres thereof in part land  
 brought by the said James Cooper of Benjamin Melton and the residue brought at a salary commis-  
 sion under an Order of Southampton County Court also the following parcels of land all being and lying  
 in the County of Southampton to wit One tract Containing One hundred and fifty four acres purchased  
 by the said Braminta of Peter Payne as more appearly by reference to his Recd. of recd. also a tract  
 of land containing three hundred and ten acres called the old place which was allotted to the said  
 Braminta in the division of her deceased fathers lands also a tract of land lying on Melton River  
 Containing one hundred and four acres brought by the said Braminta of Thomas B. Turner and others  
 as will further appear by reference to their Deed which is of record also the following Negro Slave held  
 thus future increase to wit Tom Isaac Matthew Parker Lucy Nancy Dolly Polly Gilly also  
 Eliza Berry Bob Daniel Dawson and Satchaw the last six mentioned of which are subject to a  
 Deed or Inst. executed to Stephen Mendenhall for the benefit of Mrs J. Mendenhall having date the 1st day  
 of May Eighteen hundred and twenty Eight also the following Negro Slave held by the said Robert  
 Birchell Jr. Braminta his wife as the Donor of the said Braminta in the Estate of her deceased husband Jas  
 Ben Rufus John Ephraim Simon Jacob Elias Park Bucky Kiply Pleasant Sebastian with  
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 with their future increase also Eight Miles three horses one Jack and one Harry forty five head  
 of Cattle two hundred and fifty head of hogs all their household and Kitchen furniture plantation  
 Wards with the increase of the stock and all the Crops of Corn what Cotton and other or any  
 other kind or description which are considered as growing as well as all future future Crops which  
 may be pursued on the said before mentioned lands To have And to hold to him the said Robert Birchell Jr.  
 for the property aforesaid with all its appurtenances to him and his heirs forever Upon the 1st March  
 shall that the said James Cooper is to obtain possession of all the said property and to superintend  
 manage the same to the best advantage that he is to raise and gather in the Crops and sell the same  
 and apply out of the proceeds fifteen hundred dollars annually to the relief of the said Birchell Jr.  
 the said James Cooper shall for one year to apply the proceeds as above directed that  
 to say if he shall neglect to apply fifteen hundred dollars such and every year to the relief of the  
 said Birchell Jr. up to the time of sale whereof fail to give counter security and fully discharge and  
 release the said Brinsford and Harris from their respective securityships aforesaid the said Robert  
 Birchell Jr. is hereby empowered after duly advertising the time and place of sale for thirty days in  
 a public newspaper published in the Town of Petersburg to sell at public Auction for cash  
 the property herein before contained and described with its appurtenances and file for record that  
 sale may settle the expenses of this Inst. then the respective terms which the said Cooper shall be  
 indebted to each of them and the surplus if any to the said Cooper or his heirs and the said James Cooper  
 and Braminta his wife Covenanted the said Birchell that he shall have a good title to the said property  
 the purpose aforesaid and the said Birchell Covenant that he will well and truly execute the
