assigns One certain tract or parcel of land to wit the said Elias Luter now residing at a place by name
being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by a late survey forty seven acres &c the same more
or less and bounded as follows to wit by the land of William Lawrence Samuel Foster John Johnson Elias
Johnson James Harris and Wlad Luter with all houses barns stables buildings yards fences also
such orchards lands tenements pastures woods meadows also certain privileged profits commons or
advantages and emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances which now or to the said tract parcel or parcel of
land belonging or appertaining thereto and the successors and assigns and remainder and reversionary
