and Seven hundred and Sixty dollars and twenty five cents money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Lewis Morell at or before
the recording and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted
begun and for a term of years and confirmed and by these presents they and each of them with grant
