thousand eight hundred and thirty Between William Parker and Polly his wife of the County of Southampton
North Carolina and Lucy Morrell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Elizabeth
Bryant of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part. Wherein the said
the said William Parker and Polly his wife and Lucy Morrell for and in consideration of the
Sum of One hundred and twenty Dollars current Money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the
said Elizabeth Bryant at or before the ratifying and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these
presents they and each of them do hereby grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto her the said
Elizabeth Bryant her heirs and assigns forever One Certain tract or parcel of land &c. situated
and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Luke's containing by
survey forty three acres being part of the land of William Bryant deceased known as follows
to wit Beginning at a black gum standing in a bounded path, a corner for E. P. Morrell
James Bryant and Lewis Morrell thence along said Lewis Morrell's line S. 73° E. 65 poles to a post
oak stump thence S. 85° E. 65 poles to a post thence S. 73° E. 65 poles to a red oak a run corner for
Lewis Morrell thence along his line S. 73° E. 65 poles to a post a corner for Lucy Morrell on said
Lewis Morrell's line thence along said Lucy Morrell's line S. 73° E. 65 poles to said post of Lewis
